# Adding Column IDs and Notes



## Column ID

Column IDs can be used for various purposes such as for Jump links or CSS style targetting to isolate others.

## Block Note

Add a small note to make it easy for column indentification within pagebuilder when there are multiple columns.

Column Container

Column ID

Enter a unique ID for this column.

Block Note

Add a note for self - to identify this block.

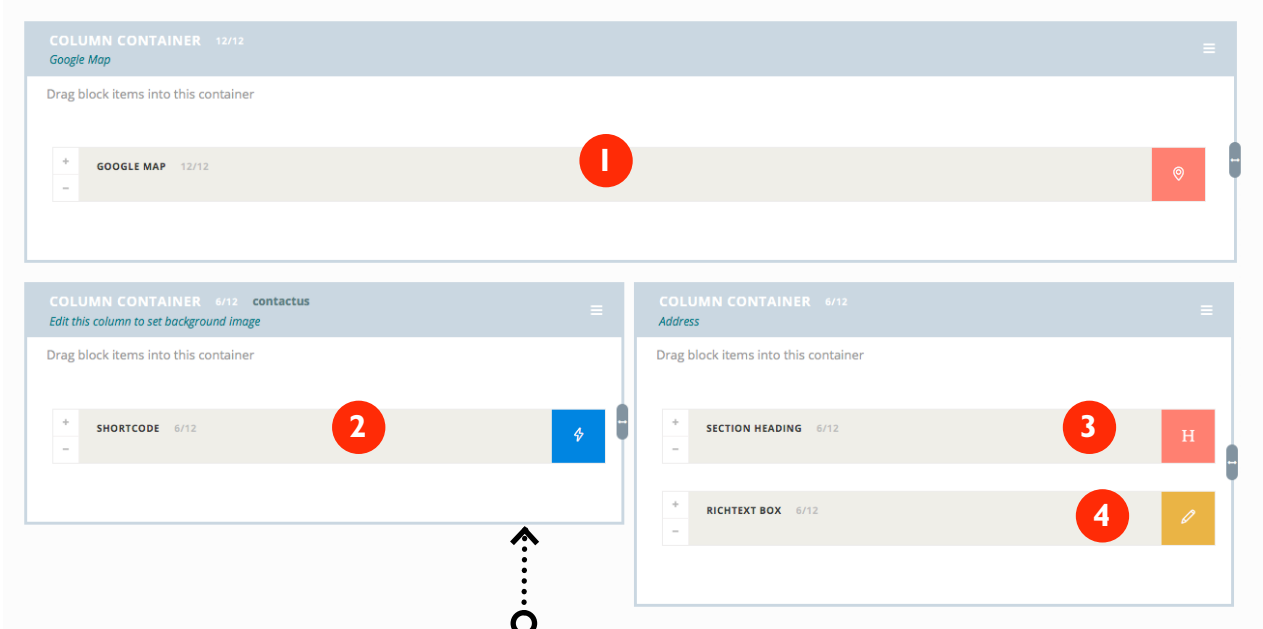

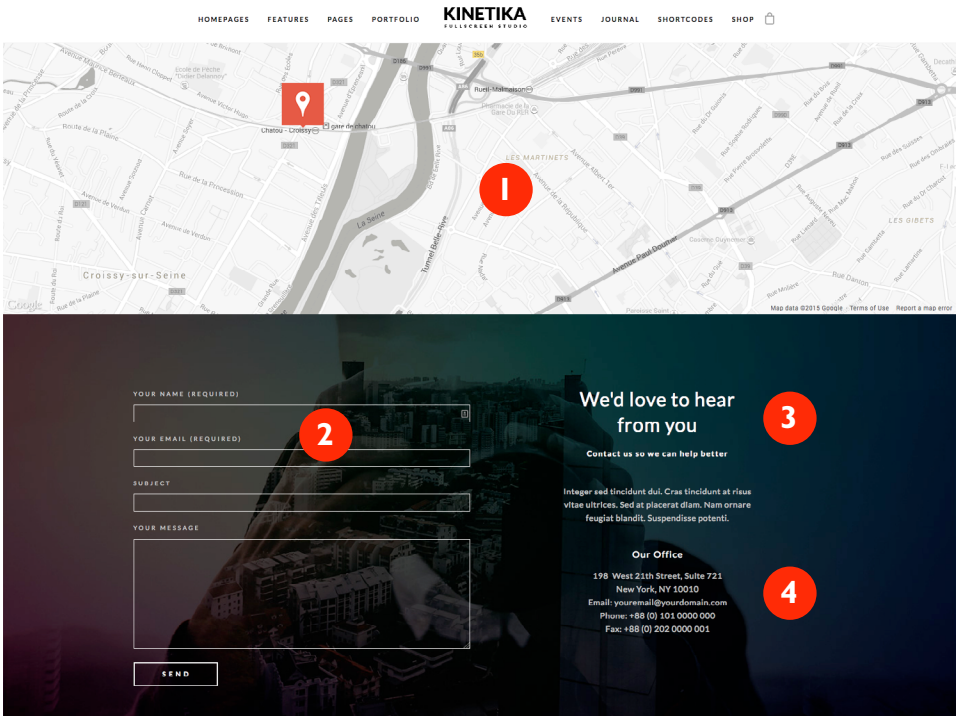
# Row of Columns

## Row of columns

In a row of columns the properties such as background color, background image or margins are applied from the first column to the whole row.



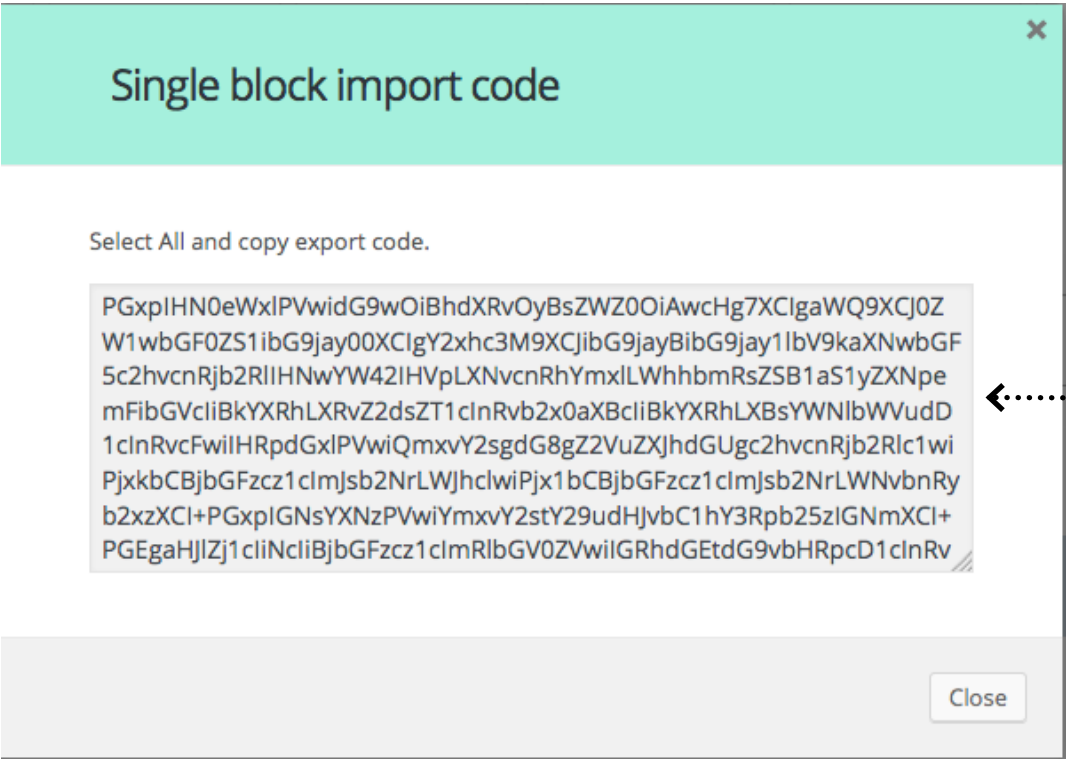
Background from 1st Column in the Row.



Background is set from first column in the Row.

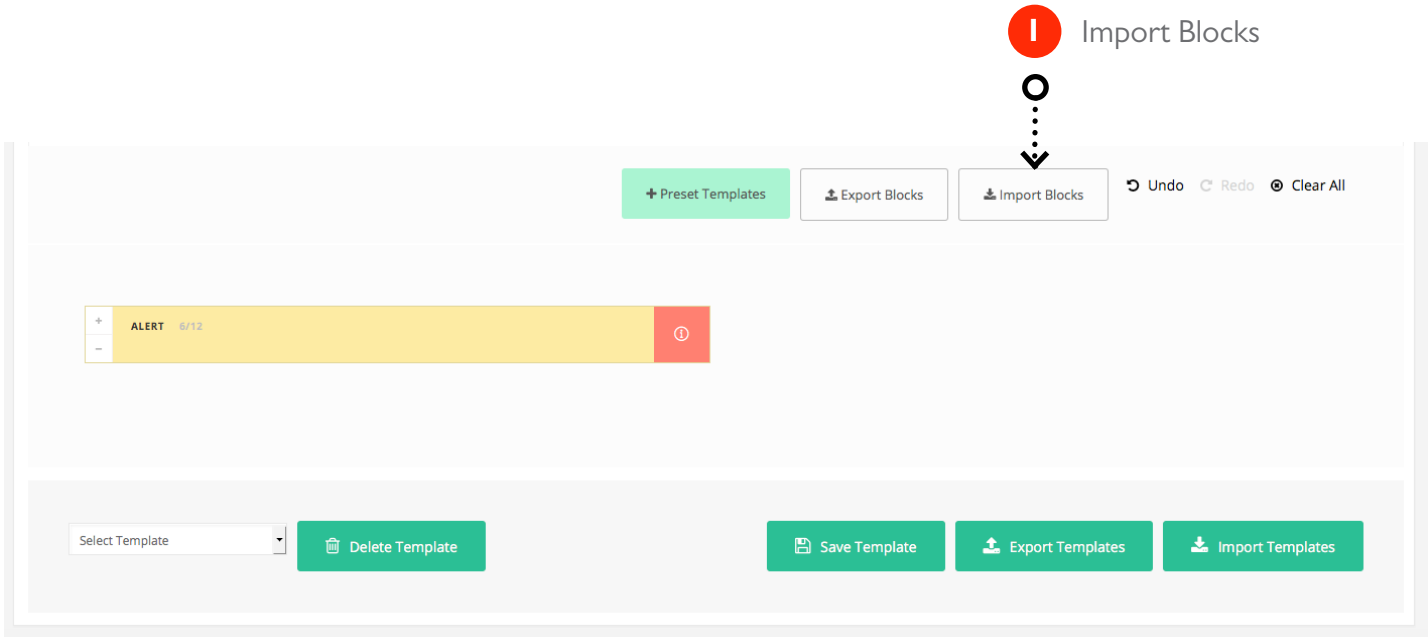

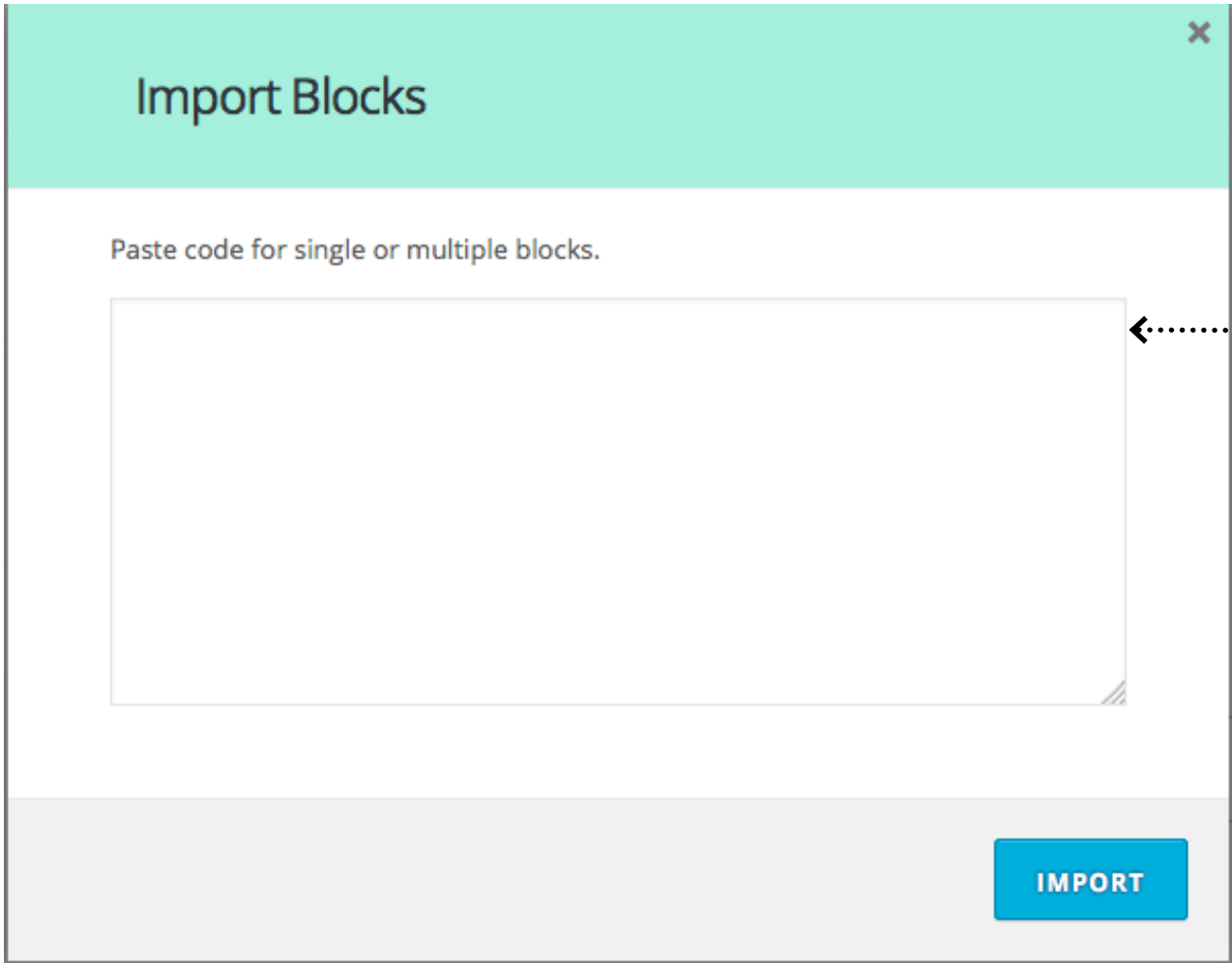

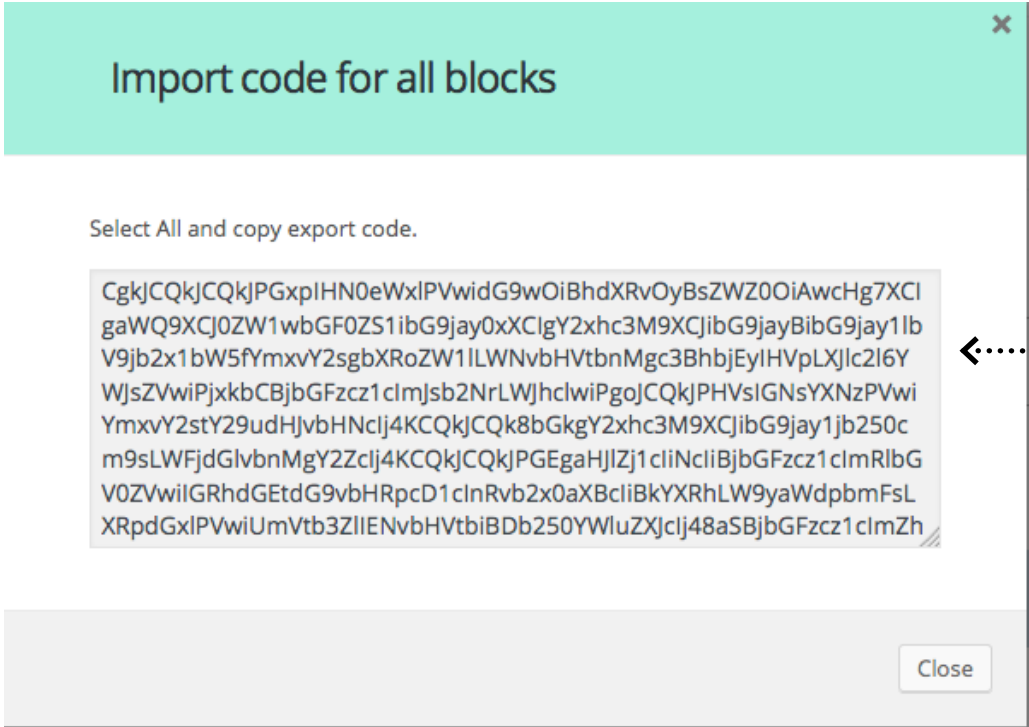
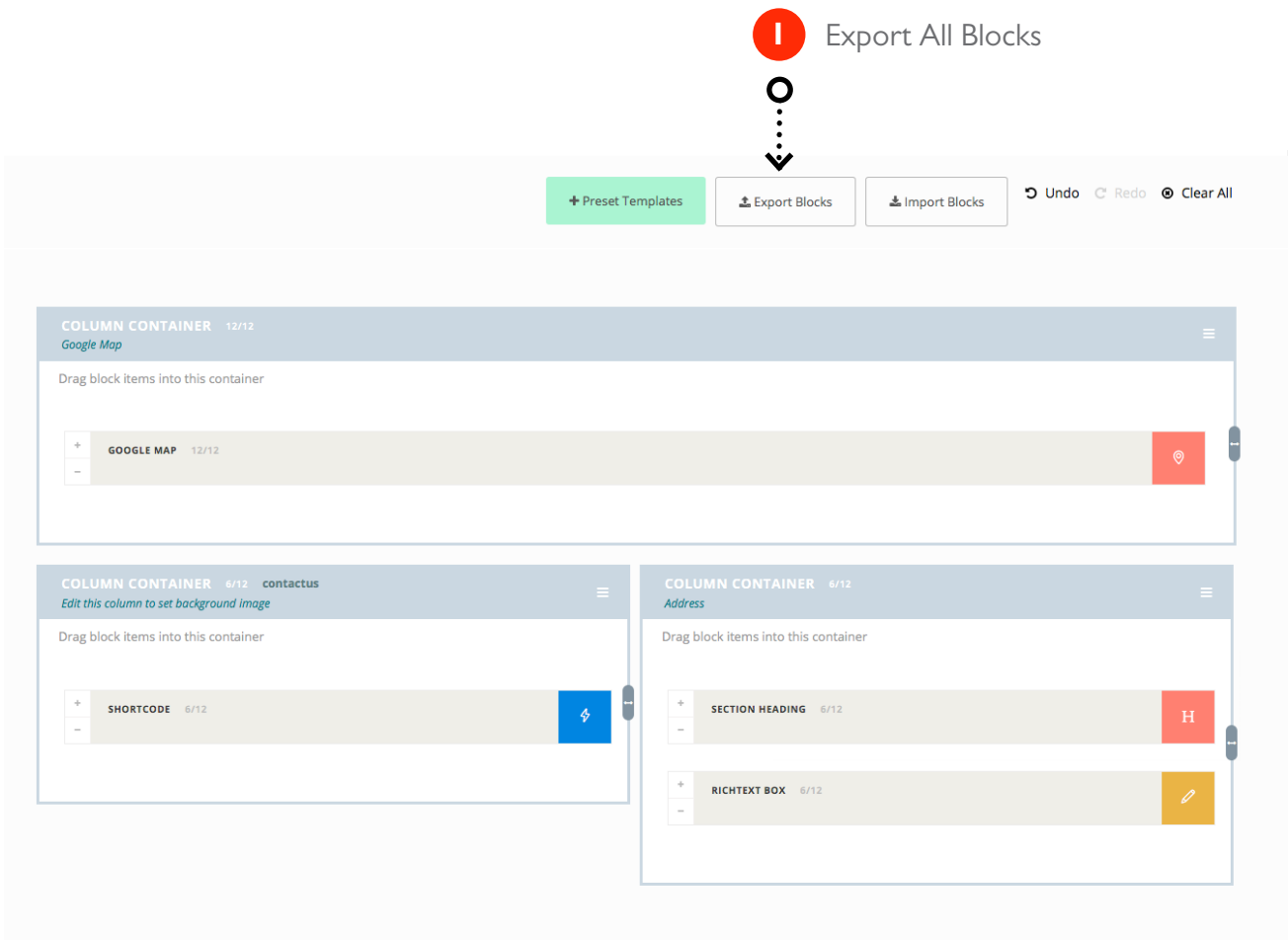
Single block import code

1 Import Blocks

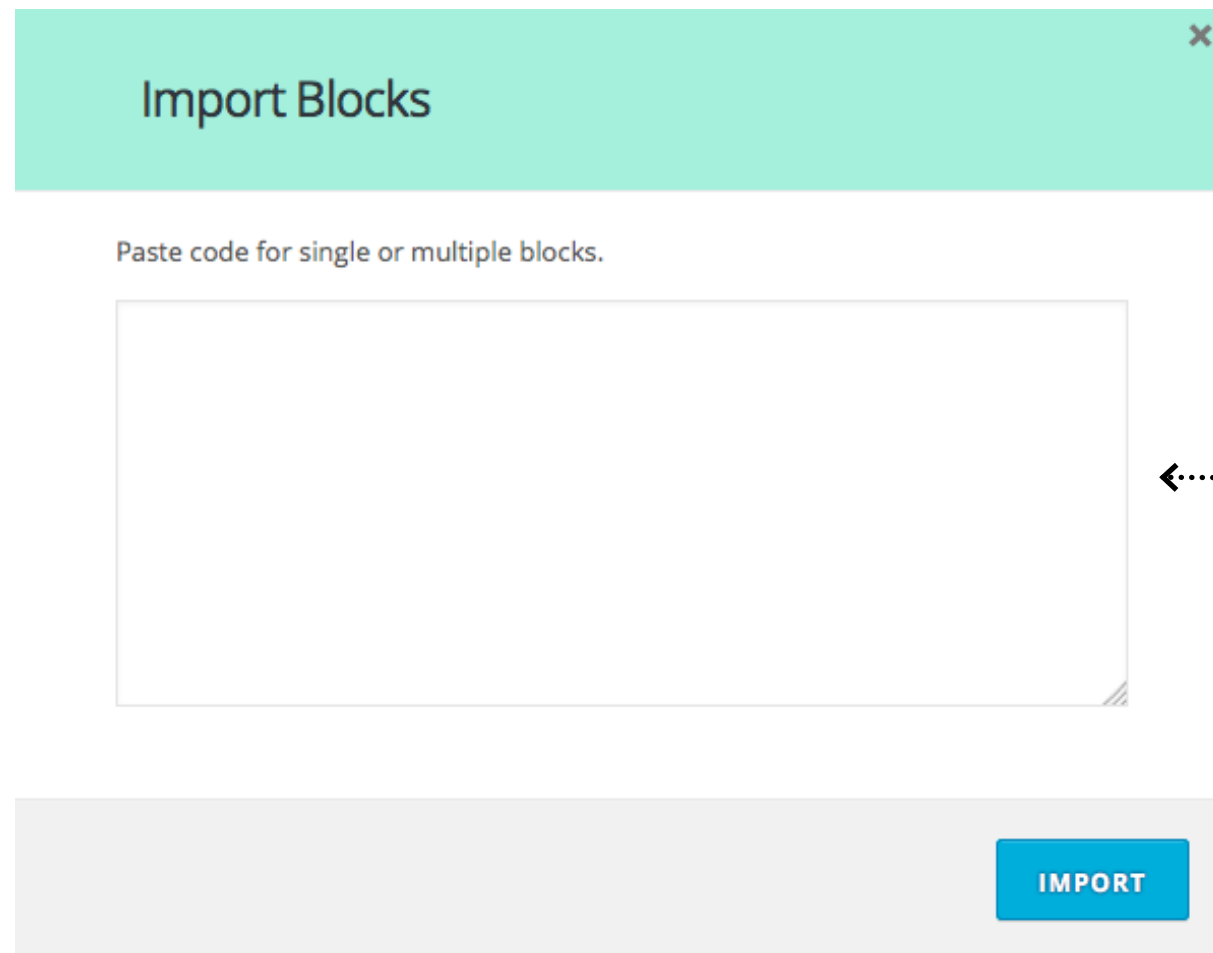
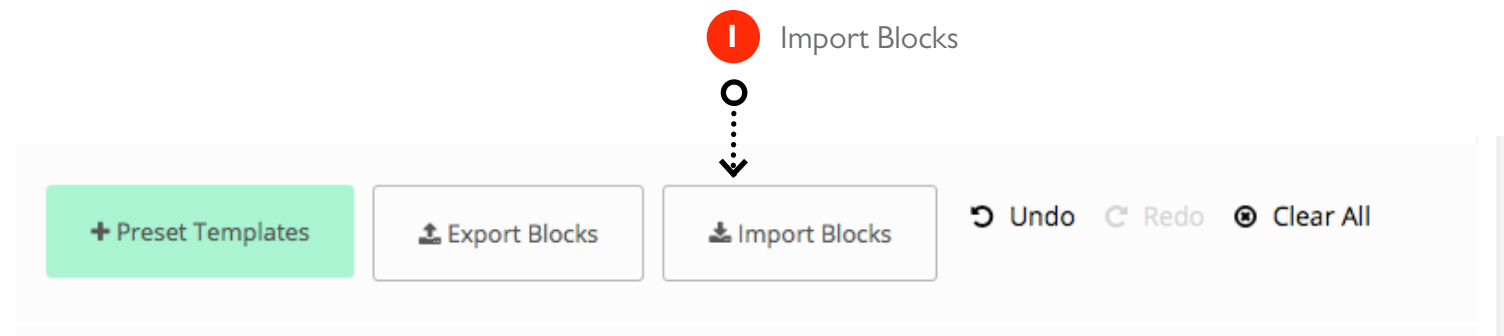


2 Import Blocks

Export code contains all blocks seen in page builder.

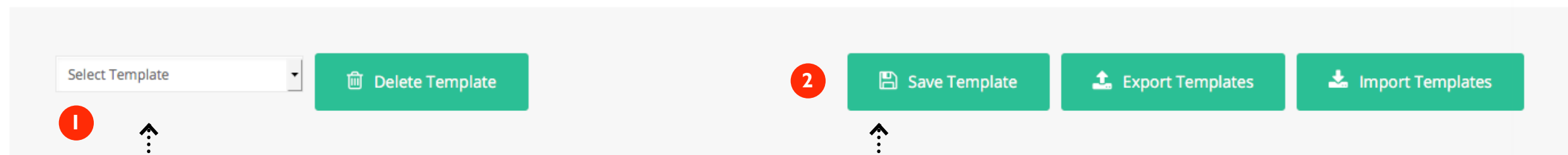

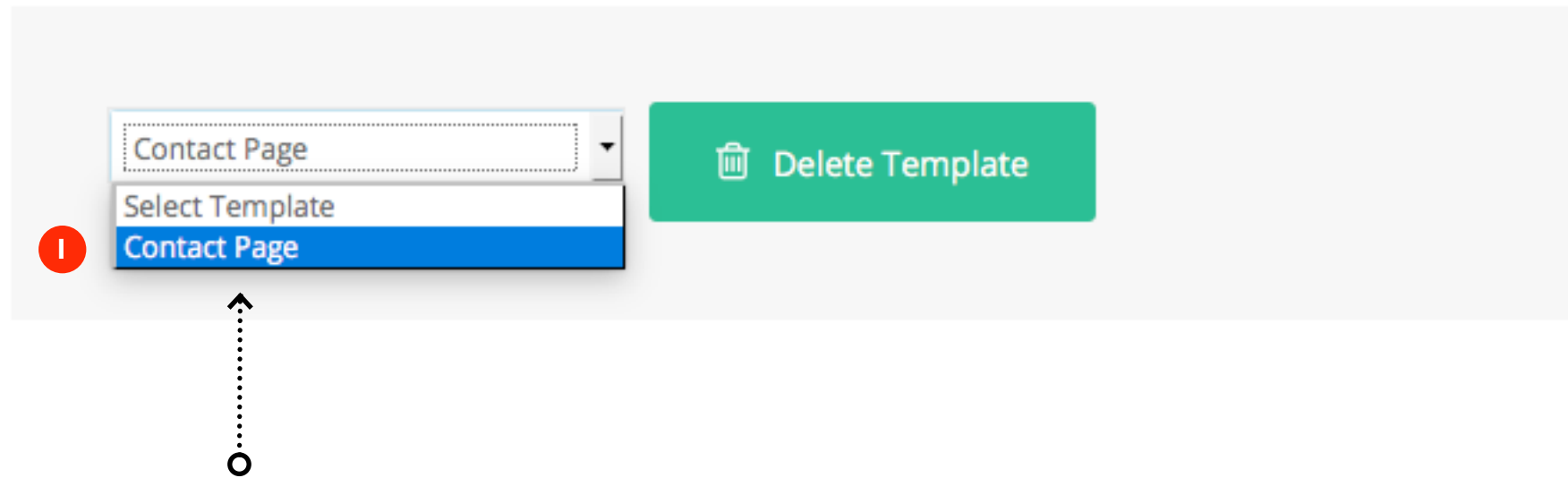


## **Saved Template selector.**

Saved Templates will appear in this selector.

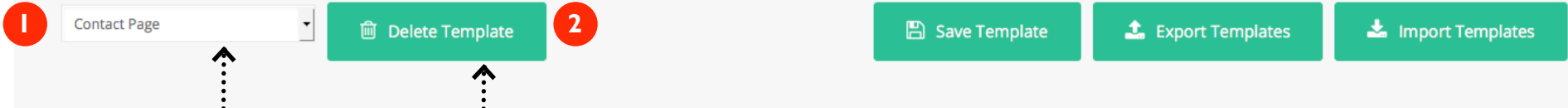
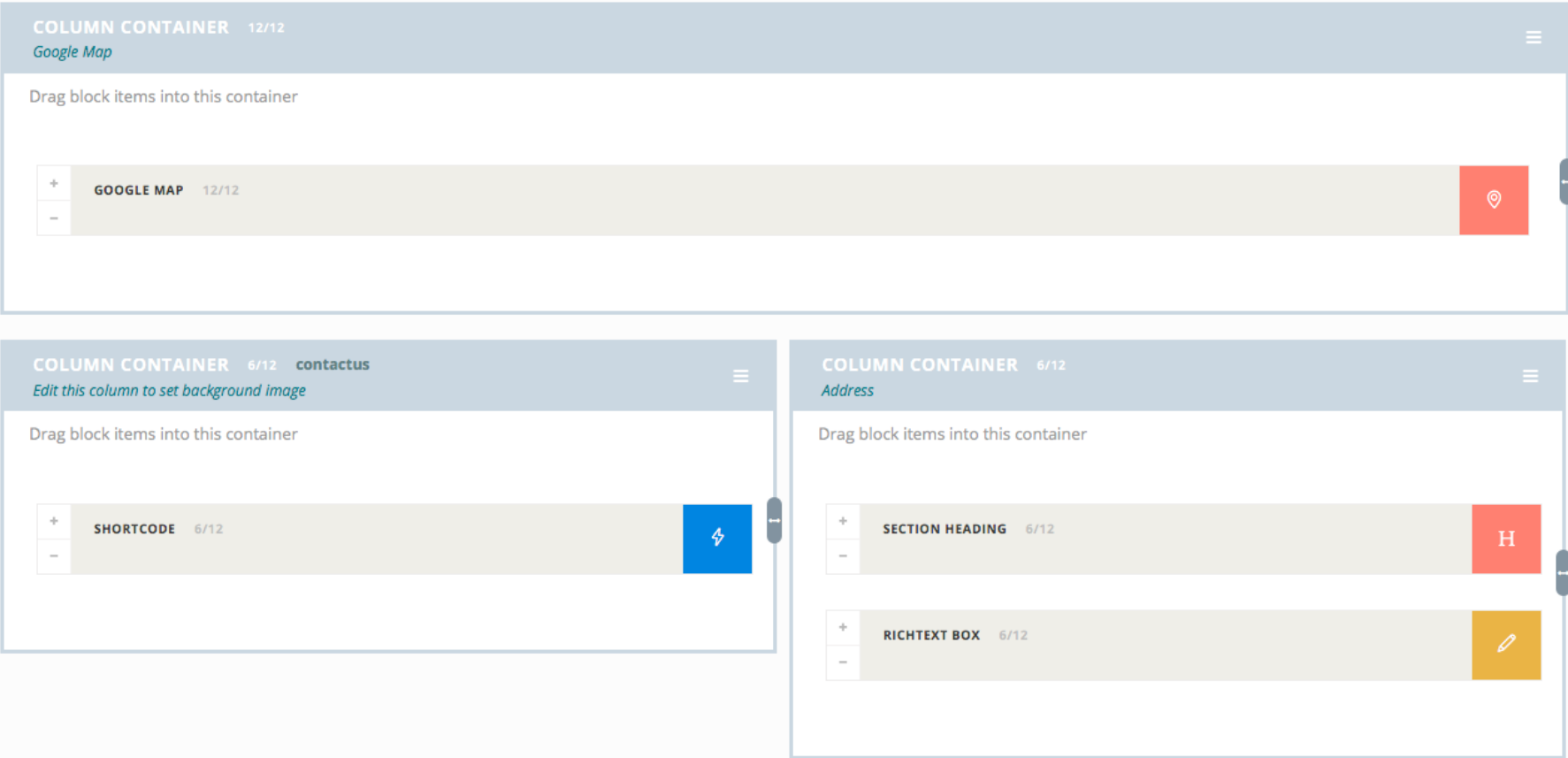
## **Save Template**

Click this button to Save Template. Enter a unique template name and choose 'Save'



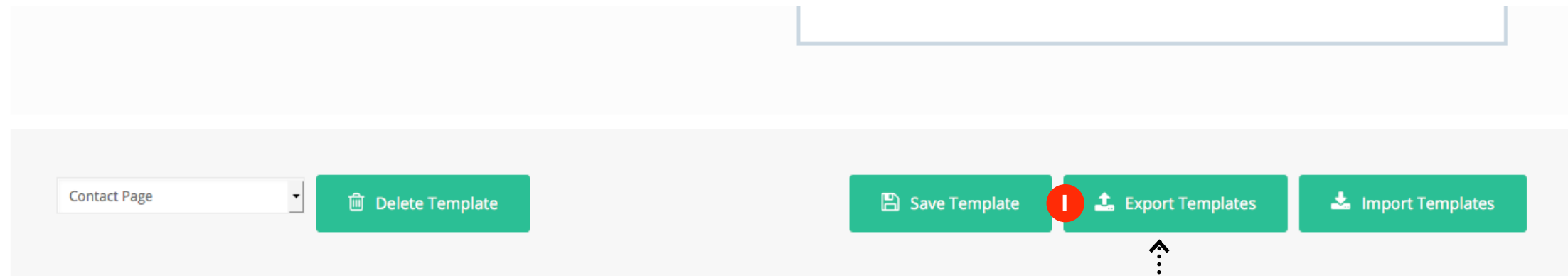
### Template loader

Simply choose a saved template from this list to load the saved template.



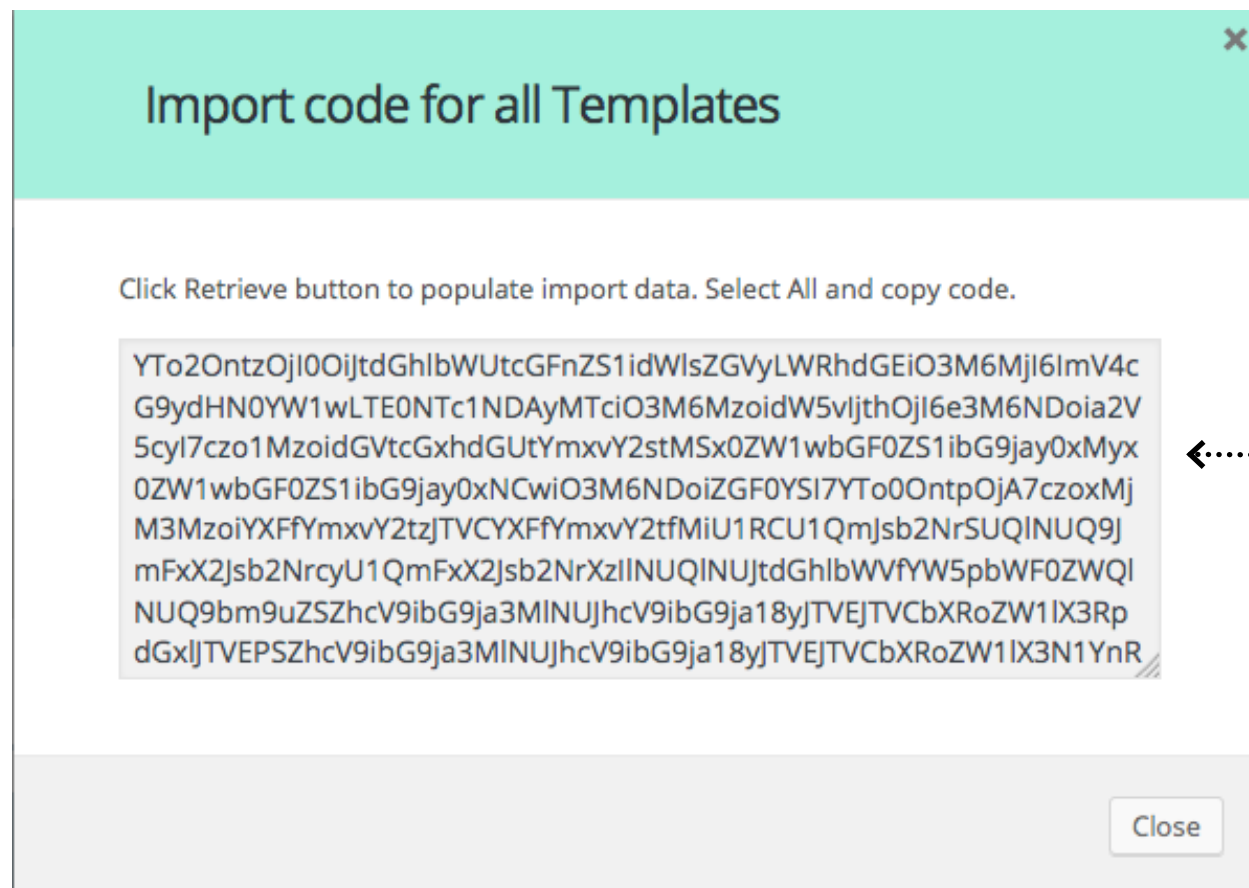
**Template selector**

Choose to grab export code for all Saved Templates in the template selector.

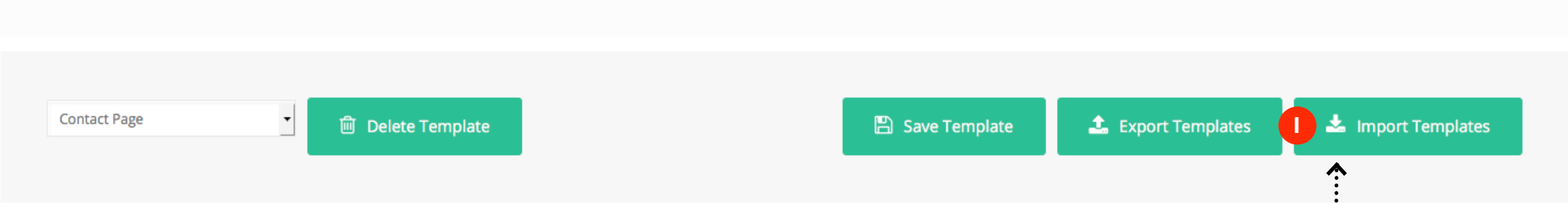

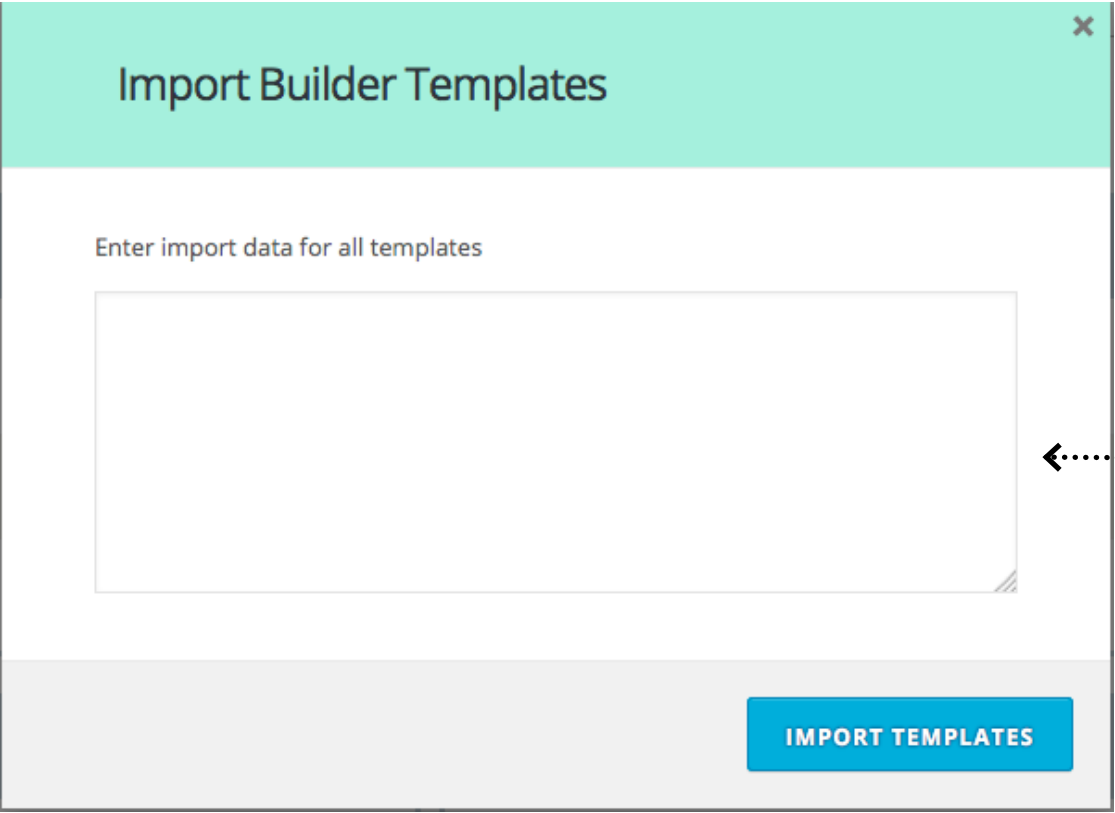
