You are now the proud owner of the most innovative podcasting WordPress theme on the market. This theme is very powerful and comes with many premium features. **Please be sure to check this manual to enjoy all of its features.**

PRODUCT LICENSE AND USAGE

The license covers the installation on one domain. The owner of the purchase code owns the license, which can be transferred to your customer.

The purchase code is required for automated installations, updates and helpdesk support access. **You are not allowed to install this theme on multiple web domains** with a single license. You are free to perform multiple local installations for testing and development purposes.

You are free to modify and edit the theme source code and its plugins however you want, but please be aware that **the support does not cover issues consisting in customized theme versions or any problem caused by code changed done by the customer**. 1.2 Plugins in bundle

This theme has several bundled plugins that allows to perform special tasks, as custom fields, theme options, special layout, shortcodes and so on. Some are free plugins from the repository, some are original theme plugins, and some are premium plugins from third party developers.

Premium bundled plugins are provided with “bundle” license. This means that **they are totally functional without purchasing any additional license**, and **you do not need to purchase a standard license or “activate” them.**

We provide the updates for these plugins with the theme updates, after testing the new versions with the theme. If you want to receive direct support and automated updates for bundled premium plugins, you are free to purchase a standard license for them, but this is up to you and **not required to use the theme.**

The product license doesn't cover the installation of the bundled plugins on other themes or websites.

2.1 Support

SUPPORT TERMS OF SERVICE

This theme comes with 6 months of official support. Once expired you can purchase the service again.

Important

The support covers **only** questions concerning this theme and QuantumThemes custom plugins. **The support doesn't include any code customizations or compatibility issues with any third party plugin not provided with the theme.** More info: http://themeforest.net/page/item_support_policy

The installation service is not part of the product support, but don't worry, **this manual covers the entire procedure step by step**, and we did our best to **automate the process** as much as possible.

If your request is something that is not covered by support, you can [hire a developer on Envato Studio](#).

3.1 System Requirements

HOSTING

Please be sure to have a Linux PHP + MySQL WordPress hosting. For optimal performance on a tiny budget, we recommend this hosting provider <https://wphost2go.com/qantum> who tested all of our themes and **guarantees top speed and high level security for your website.**

This theme requires the following:

- Linux server
- WordPress 4.9 or higher
- MySQL 5.6 or higher
- PHP 7.1 or higher

The theme also requires the following PHP libraries for an optimal performance:

- CURL enabled
- .htaccess
- ModRewrite ON
- upload_max_filesize: **512M** (to support upload of mp4 videos)
- memory_limit: **256M**
- post_max_size: **256M**

How to verify your server limits: please use this plugin <https://wordpress.org/plugins/wordpress-php-info/>.

Please follow this reading to discover **how to increase your server limits.**

IF YOU SEE AN ERROR “ARE YOU SURE YOU WANT TO DO THIS”

or **other memory or upload limit errors** during the upload, please use one of these solutions (any server is different so one

of these methods may work better than the others depending on the server settings)

1. add this in the .htaccess file of your server

```
php_value memory_limit 256M
php_value post_max_size 256M
php_value upload_max_filesize 256M
php_value max_execution_time 1800
```

2. add this to wp-config.php

```
define('WP_MEMORY_LIMIT', '256M');
```

3. create a text file, call it **php.ini** and put this text in it, then upload it in the wordpress root folder:

```
upload_max_filesize =512M
post_max_size =512M
```

If you are still experiencing any issue, please contact your hosting provider and request an update of your PHP to version 7. This will most probably solve all your issues, because latest php version has a much better performance and allows to bypass all the hardware limitations.

IF YOU SEE AN ERROR “STYLESHEET IS MISSING”

It means you are doing it wrong. Please [read the theme installation chapter to proceed](#).

3.2 WordPress installation

This product is a WordPress Theme. This means that you need a valid and updated installation of WordPress to get started. As this manual regards only the the Theme product itself, if you are new to WordPress, you can find useful information in the official WordPress Codex:

If your hosting provides Softaculous or Installatron, you can easily install WordPress from your **Cpanel**.

3.3 Theme Installation

First of all, please be sure your **server meets the system requirements** and that your **WordPress installation** is correctly performed.

You can install your new theme in the following ways:

1. From the admin dashboard, using the WordPress theme installer (easiest method).
2. or manually via FTP

Please make sure that you start from a fresh WordPress installation, **without any plugin(s).**

IMPORTANT NOTE BEFORE INSTALLING THE THEME:

This theme provides **a child theme**, making it easier to update your site with new theme versions without losing any customizations or settings. The following instructions will teach you how to correctly install and activate the theme using the child theme, **which will make your life much easier down the line:**

AUTOMATIC THEME INSTALLATION FROM WP-ADMIN

1. Login to your website in **/wp-admin**
2. Go to **Appearance > Themes**
3. Click **Install Themes** and then **Upload**
4. Click on the **“Browse”** button and select the zipped folder of the theme from your computer.
5. Upload the theme called **wpcast.zip** but **DO NOT ACTIVATE IT**
6. Once done click on **“Return to themes”**
7. Click **“add new”** and upload the theme **wpcast-child.zip**
8. **Activate wpcast-child.zip**
9. Install the required plugins (**next manual chapter**)

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Error: The theme is missing the style.css stylesheet

If you see this error, it means that **you are trying to upload the entire product package instead of the simple theme zip file**. Please **unzip** the product folder in your computer and **upload only the theme zip file** and the child theme’s zip file.

Error: Are you sure you want to do this?

Please check [system requirements](#).

MANUAL THEME INSTALLATION (FTP INSTALLATION)

1. Download the **product zip** from Themeforest (not the full product) and **expand it on your computer**.
2. Locate the correct **theme folder inside of the unzipped folder**, it will contain wpcast-child.zip and wpcast.zip
3. **Make sure you unzip the correct theme folders (wpcast.zip and wpcast-child.zip). This will produce 2 folders: wpcast and wpcast-child**
4. Connect to your hosting provider using an **FTP** client (e.g. Filezilla is one of the best free FTP clients, you can get it [here](#))
5. Navigate to your WordPress installation folder (usually is not the root folder but it should be **public_html**, **www** or something else, depending on your hosting provider settings). To be sure that you are in the WordPress folder, you should see the following three folders inside:
 - wp-content
 - wp-admin
 - wp-includes
6. Navigate to **wp-content/themes**
7. Upload the two previously unzipped theme folders (wpcast and wpcast-child, see step 2. above) in **wp-content/themes** folder.
8. Now open your browser (we recommend Google Chrome), navigate to the admin dashboard of your wordpress site (usually [yoursite.com/wp-admin](#))
9. Go to **Appearance-> themes** and activate: **Wpcast Child**
10. Install the required plugins ([next manual chapter](#))

If you encounter any activation problem please check the system requirements, your WordPress version and disable any plugin you may have in your website.

3.4 Plugins installation

Once you activate the theme, you'll see the **a notification asking to install the required plugins. Follow the instructions provided on screen to complete the procedure.**

3.5 Theme update

AUTOMATIC THEME UPDATE:

1. Make a website backup. We suggest [All In One Migration](#) plugin, or you can do a manual backup.
2. Download your .po and .mo translation files from the /languages theme subfolder, if any is used
3. Be sure to have the Envato Market plugin installed
4. [Create your API key](#)
5. Click on Envato Market on the left column
6. Once you add the API key in the settings page, you can update your theme from the main Envato Market page
7. **If you are using the CHILD theme, DO NOT activate Wpcast after the update, as it will switch to the parent theme activation.**
8. **[Be sure to update all the required plugins \(go in Theme Dashboard > Plugins\)](#)**
9. The child theme doesn't need to be updated. [More info](#)

IMPORTANT: After updating the theme **remember to update all the required plugins**. If you don't, some parts of your website won't work properly.

MANUAL UPDATE (FTP):

You can download new updates from [Themeforest.net/downloads](https://themeforest.net/downloads) for as long as the product is maintained

A full file and database backup is recommended before updating.

No pages or site contents are deleted when updating themes or plugins.

If you used the child theme, just replace the main theme file and leave the child theme intact.

1. Unzip the theme folder on your local computer (for example on the desktop)
2. **Backup** your old theme version located in wp-content/themes/wpcast
3. **Upload the theme via FTP replacing the old theme folder in wp-content/themes**
4. [Update the plugins](#)

Important:

Each update version contains the list of changes in wpcast/readme.txt. Before updating always check what's new, as some big updates may require additional actions.

3.6 Plugins update

HOW TO UPDATE THE PLUGINS:

1. Go to Appearance > Install Plugins
2. Click **“Click here to refresh”** if prompted
3. Select all
4. Select **“Update”** from the dropdown and run the procedure

ERRORS TROUBLESHOOTING

In case of any error, you will generally get as well the instructions for the resolution. If nothing works, please get in touch with the support (check please [support](#))

WPBAKERY PAGE BUILDER UPDATE (VISUAL COMPOSER)

The theme may provide bundled plugins such as Visual Composer or others. Due to Envato's licensing rules, we provide the plugins as a built-in feature provided under a [Bundle extended license](#), which forbids us to provide License Certificate and Purchase Code to our customers.

We can provide plugin's updates only when we provide a new version of the theme. This because we need to test the new plugin versions with the theme and be sure that everything works well together before distributing theme.

It will be our duty to provide fast updates in case security issues or severe WordPress incompatibilities appears.

If you see any message asking to provide a purchase code of the bundled plugins, you can discard it or purchase a Personal License on [Codecanyon.net](#), but we can't ensure that updated versions will work smoothly with our theme as the ones we distributed, as it can be untested. The version we provide is tested and working fine with the theme. You don't need to buy a personal license. Is an optional thing.

3.7 Demo Contents


DEMO IMPORT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Be sure that all of the required **plugins are installed**
2. Be **sure** that that you **activated the Child theme** (as explained in the installation page)
3. **If prompted**, be sure to activate the purchase code of your theme

Please remember that all of the contents will be imported under your current user. **If the demo displays multiple users, they will all be ignored to avoid security breaches on your website.**

HOW TO INSTALL THE DEMO CONTENTS:

1. Click Appearance > Import Demo Data
2. Click Import Demo Data and wait a couple of minutes




Notes:

1. Existing contents will not be deleted

4.01 Title, tagline and favicon


This theme is customizable using the standard WordPress theme customizer function.

You can access the customizer visiting **Appearance->Customize**. Then to add the Site Title, tagline and Site Icon go to **Site Identity** section.



Adding the Site Title

Fill the field **Site Title** and Tagline and click **Publish**.



The tagline in this theme is not visible in frontend, but will be used by Search Engines to complete the website title and help your SEO positioning.

ADDING THE SITE ICON

Under **Site Icon** section, click on **Select image**.





Under **Header background image** section, click on **Select image**.




Upload the image to your media library (suggested image dimensions: 1660 by 790 pixels) and click **Select**.

PARALLAX EFFECT


You can enable parallax effect on scroll for archive and default header by turning on the switch.


If using Powerpress, you can hide the default player by enabling this option, so the podcasts will play through the theme featured player.

5.01 Creating a podcast

Creating a simple podcast is very easy:



1. Add a new post and set it to **audio**
2. Add the audio file to the post: you can drag it in the content or add a new block



3. Publish

If the post belongs to a serie, is better to create the serie in advance.

It is highly recommended to add a podcast to a **single serie**, while it works fine while having multiple categories.

Alternative methods: if you don't want the additional player to appear in the body of the post, you can add a meta field called `audio_file` to the post, and set the mp3 URL as value of the field.

If using PowerPress or Seriously Simple Podcasting, remember to copy the URL of the audio file in the special field of the plugin.

5.02 How to create a blog post

CREATE A NEW POST


This theme provides **2 type of posts**:




USING GUTENBERG BLOCKS


Blocks are a great new tool for building engaging content. **With blocks, you can insert, re-arrange, and style multimedia content with very little technical knowledge.** Instead of using custom code, you can add a block and focus on your content.

Here's a selection of the default blocks included with Gutenberg:

When creating a new post for your blog, click on the plus icon on the top left area of your content to add a block.




Then you can choose a block to start with.



You can add as many blocks you want in the post, customizing and sorting them easily. For further explanations about Gutenberg blocks, we suggest you get an overview on its official page: <https://wordpress.org/gutenberg/>


POST AND TAGS CATEGORIES

Click on **Document** on the top right corner, then you can easily choose categories and tags for your posts by opening the relative tabs on the right sidebar.




SET A FEATURED IMAGE FOR YOUR POST

On the right sidebar of your post, open the tab featured image and click on **Set featured image**. This will open the WordPress media library where you could choose an existing photo or upload a new one.




CREATING A GALLERY WITH GUTENBERG EDITOR

Adding a gallery with Gutenberg is very easy: from the block list, choose Gallery (inside Common Blocks).




Now you can upload new pics or choose existing ones.



To insert the gallery inside the post click the button **Create a new gallery** on the bottom right corner.


IMPORTANT NOTICE: if you want to open your images in a lightbox, make sure to select **Link To Media File** in Gallery Settings.



DROP CAPS AND INTRO PARAGRAPH

When editing a post in Gutenberg you can customize your intro paragraph by adding Drop Cap and its size.


First, select your paragraph block. Then, on the text settings placed inside the right sidebar, you can select the font size (S, M, L, XL) and activate the Drop Cap.



5.03 Categories

CREATING CATEGORIES

On the left sidebar click on **Categories**.



Here you can create a new category: choose a name, a slug, its hierarchy, a description and also a background image. When ready, click on **Add New Category** to save it.

Add New Category

Name

The name is how it appears on your site.

Slug

The "slug" is the URL-friendly version of the name. It is usually all lowercase and contains only letters, numbers, and hyphens.

Parent Category

Categories, unlike tags, can have a hierarchy. You might have a Jazz category, and under that have children categories for Bebop and Big Band. Totally optional.

Description

The description is not prominent by default; however, some themes may show it.

ADDING BACKGROUND IMAGE TO CATEGORIES

Click **Add Image**.


Image

Choose an image and click on **Insert into post**.

Make sure to select the right size for the image: we recommend 1600px wide pictures.

CATEGORIES ORDER


You can sort post categories thanks to a bundled plugin called **Category Order and Taxonomy Terms Order**. Under Posts section, click on **Taxonomy Order**.




Now you can drag and drop your categories. Click on **Update** to save it.

5.04 Adding categories to menu


First, go to Appearance > Menus.



Then make sure that Categories are selected on the Screen Options panel.




Now on the left sidebar, you will find a new item called **Categories**. You can select one or more items and click to **Add to Menu**.



Last, remember to save the menu clicking **Save Menu**.

5.05 Managing comments

You can enable/disable comments on future posts or already published posts by going into your Discussion settings.


5.07 Podcast Series

“QT Serie” is a custom taxonomy added by the plugin Qt Series Plugin, bundled with the theme.


We recommend using this taxonomy for this theme instead of the ones added by SSP or Powerpress.

A serie is a list of episodes. Once you create a new serie, you can then add any podcast to it. A single podcast can be listed in multiple series, but generally only the first will appear in the frontend, even thou the episode will be listed under any serie where it belongs.

Is recommended anyway to use a single serie for each episode.



The single Feed page will highlight the latest podcast with a special “Hero” design.



HOW TO CREATE A SERIE:

Go to Posts > **QT Serie**.

Compile the Name using the name of the podcast, as for instance **"This american Life"**.

Once saved, you can add the picture that will be used as background in the series headers and cards.

A serie generates automatically a Subscribe feed link.

This leads to a valid RSS FEED that you can use in any feed reader as for instance the popular PodStation <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/detail/podstation-podcast-player/bpcageki-jmfcocgjlinnhpdogbplajjfn/related?hl=en>.

To subscribe to your feed and receive the notifications about new episodes, your listeners can copy the URL and paste it in the feed reader, to **add the feed**.



17.1 Basic podcasting with WpCast

This section will cover the basics of podcasting with WpCast and WordPress, and the most popular integrations as PowerPress, Seriously Simple Podcasting, Libsyn, Blubrry, iTunes and Google Podcasts.

What is a podcast:

The base concept is that you need a web archive with a list of podcasts, and each one must contain an MP3 source.

IMPORTANT:

Popular plugins as SSP (Seriously Simple Podcasting) or PowerPress, can add custom post types and custom taxonomies. Please remember that with the WpCast theme you won't be needing them, and you will simply use the post type "Post" and the provided taxonomy "QT Series" for the podcast series.

In the podcast industry, a podcast is often a term used to refer to a serie of podcasts. Each single podcast is then called "Episode". In this optic, a Podcast, is an archive of posts.

WpCast allows you can use for your podcast (archive) many sources:

- A "Category"
- A Serie "QT Series"
- A user archive

We suggest to use as poscast archive the "QT Serie" post type, while you should use categories as additional topic classifications, that can be shared across different series.

An example: a serie can be for instance "This American Life" and an episode can have multiple categories, as for instance "Job, family, business, money".

Then another podcast, gathered under another serie, for instance "99% Podcast", can have similar categories, as "job, technology", which can be shared across other series.

This allows the users to connect to the specific topics they like, disregarding the serie they belong to, and creating an horizontal linking that allows to discover other podcasts similar to the favorite ones.

TECHNICAL INFO ABOUT PODCASTING IN WORDPRESS

The main objective of a podcast is reach as many people as possible. With this in mind, you have to spread your episodes on every available channel.

The most popular ones are iTunes, Google Podcast and Spotify Podcast.

In order to list your episodes through those channels, you need a valid Podcast feed.

A feed is a specially formatted page that lists your entries.

WordPress and Wpcast are already creating the feed you can use for those channels. An example of a feed can be seen clicking “follow” on any archive, serie or category page.

This is what you will see



This special page is technically called an XML feed. It allows your followers to “subscribe” using their favorite softwares, and to receive a notification every time a new content will appear in that channel.

A “feed URL” is technically the only required element to list your podcast on iTunes, Google Podcast or similar.

Therefore, with the WpCast theme, you are not forced to install any extra plugin to broadcast your episodes, and you can start with the only tools provided with the theme.

To get the correct feed URL for your podcast, **while using for instance a serie**, you may want to click on the **Follow** button that is in the header of a single serie:



That URL is the one you want to use for iTunes or everything else, including personal podcast feed readers.

If you encounter any issue with your feed, **please check out the Podcast Feed chapter of the manual.**

HOSTING YOUR PODCASTS

With this theme you can host the podcasts directly in your website, using the media uploader of WordPress (**more on the Podcast chapter of the manual**). Anyway, you can host your files on every repository that is publically accessible, or on alternative repositories as Blubrry and Libsyn (check the next paragraph for more info).

If you have problems uploading large files, please read the **Requirements** section, it will guide you through possible resolutions, or you can also contact your hosting provider.

ADDITIONAL PODCASTING PLUGINS

This theme is compatible with the most popular podcasting plugins, which are

- Seriously Simple Podcasting, and
- PowerPress

The main difference is that SSP is easier to use but it misses some functionalities and connections with some third party providers. While PowerPress has quite more functionalities and is

more flexible, but requires a couple more minutes for the setup, but you won't call it "complex" either because is super intuitive and well documented.

Those plugins are **not** required for this theme, but we suggest using one of them to achieve a better control over your podcast feed. In the specific, we find Powerpress the best choice for anybody, unless you look only for simplicity.

Please check the next chapters to understand how to correctly set up those plugins for the compatibility with this theme.

17.2 Podcast rss feed

The podcast feed produced by WordPress and Wpcast is compatible with any external podcast reader

What is important to know: to be a valid podcast feed, your XML page needs to include the tag “enclosure”.

This tag is created when the post contains an mp3 track.

WHAT YOU HAVE TO REMEMBER:

Once you add an mp3 to the content, the Enclosure value is generated from the mp3 URL.

If you change the mp3 in a post, the Enclosure value WILL NOT BE REFRESHED.

WHY? because the value requires a heavy process and WordPress caches the result for faster processing. So, if you need to change the MP3 associated to a podcast episode, you will want to create a new post and delete the old one, in order to update the “enclosure” value.

This is a basic WordPress functionality, and it has strict rules.

The theme does not add any modification to that functionality and **the theme is as well not responsible for any malfunctioning with your Podcast RSS feed.**

17.3 Seriously Simple Podcasting

WpCast is compatible with Seriously Simple Podcasting. It is very useful for the users of the Castos platform, but you can use it also with self-hosted files. The plugin is free and easy to use.

For this theme, you need to follow a couple of important setting suggestions.

1. For your podcasts, be sure to use the post type **Posts**
2. For the series taxonomy, be sure to use the taxonomy **QT Series**
3. Once you create a new episodes, be sure to copy the MP3 url in the settings of the plugin, below the main post content.

PowerPress is for us the best podcasting free plugin for WordPress and it can provide great advantages combined with the Wpcast podcasting WordPress theme. **It is not only useful for Blubrry users but also for self-hosted podcasts.**

It will help you managing your RSS podcast feed.

The main advantages are:

- Help posting on Apple Podcast (ex iTunes Podcast) and Google Podcast
- Improved podcasting SEO optimization
- Importing from SoundCloud, LibSyn, PodBean, Squarespace, or other podcast RSS feed
- Migration tools: Quickly migrate from PodPress, TGS Podcasting, Seriously Simple Podcasting, Blogger, or Movable Type without losing episodes.
- **Full Apple Podcast support**
- **Full Google Podcast support**

COMPATIBILITY NOTES:

To use PowerPress with Wpcast, you have to set the Podcasting post type to **Post**, and the Podcast taxonomy archive to “**QT Series**”.

PLAYER:

If you **don't** want to use the provided QT Music Player, you can use the player from PowerPress. It has other great advantages, but you'll need to give up the non-stop music across pages (**disable the Ajax plugin provided with the theme**).

Anyway, we suggest to NOT use the player from PowerPress, and use instead the theme's one.

USE THEME'S PLAYER WITH POWERPRESS

To do so, in Appearance > Customizer you will find a section dedicated to PowerPress, where you can enable a function to hide the player from PowerPress and use instead the one from the theme.

PODCAST EPISODE

After creating a podcast normally, you can copy the MP3 file URL and paste it in the Media field of the PowerPress section, below the post content.

HOW TO TRANSLATE

This theme is very easy to translate as the .mo .po (pot) files are provided within the language sub folder of the theme.

In the main theme folder in wp-content/themes/wpcast you'll find a "languages" folder.

It contains a model to translate the theme using Poedit or other .mo .po translation softwares.

1. Start up Poedit.
2. In Poedit goto File -> New from POT/PO file...
3. Select and Open the pot file from the languages folder.
4. Enter your name, email address, your language and country (i.e. French fr_FR, German de_DE) to the setting form. For the correct language identifier check the column **WP Locale at this page**
5. Click the Update button in the main Poedit UI.
6. Save the file:
 1. **For a plugin** like filename-xx_XX.po with xx_XX for your language and country.
 2. **For a theme** xx_XX.po
7. In WordPress Admin, settings -> general set the language of your country.
8. **That's it**, go to your WordPress blog and see your translation in action. Enjoy your blogging!!!

Please notice that **some strings may be in the plugins and not in the theme!**
